QUALIFYING DATES

Federal, Statewide, Multicounty, County, and Special District Candidates (including write-ins)

Noon, June 18, 2018 – Noon, June 22, 2018

QUALIFYING FEES

Major party candidates will pay a fee equal to 6% of the salary of the office sought. This includes the 2% party assessment.

Minor party candidates will pay a fee equal to 4% of the salary of the office sought plus any applicable party assessment.

No Party Affiliation and Nonpartisan candidates will pay a fee equal to 4% of the salary of the office sought.

PETITION METHOD INFORMATION

All candidates (except Soil & Water Conservation District candidates) shall obtain the signatures of a number of qualified voters equal to 1% of the number of registered voters at the last general election. In Alachua County, candidates will need to submit 1,779 valid signatures to qualify by the Petition Method.

Minor Party Candidates: Minor party candidates will pay the same qualifying fee as candidates with No Party Affiliation, plus any applicable party assessment.

Residency Requirements: Must be a resident of the District for which he/she runs at the time of election. Write-in candidates must reside in the district they seek to represent at the time of qualification. Candidate must be a qualified elector of Alachua County per F.S. 99.021.
