**NOTICE:** Any protest or challenge based on the belief that any ballot is illegal due to any defect apparent on the Voter's Certificate must be filed with the Canvassing Board before the ballot is removed from the mailing envelope, and shall not be accepted after the ballot has been removed from the mailing envelope. If any person decides to appeal any decision made at these meetings, they will need a record of the proceedings, and they need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made. **This notice applies to all meetings.**

**BALLOT TABULATION:** Results will not be tabulated for vote-by-mail ballots or early voting ballots until after the polls close on Election Day.

Each candidate, political party official, political committee official, or an authorized designee thereof, shall be granted reasonable access upon request to review or inspect ballot materials before canvassing or tabulation. You must call the Elections Office at (352) 374-5252 and request access at least 24 hours prior to such access being granted. An attestation must be completed before access is granted. Authorized designees must provide a signed letter from the candidate or entity designating them as a representative. ### January 25, 2022 Special Run-Off Election Schedule

**January 10 – Monday – 10:00 AM – LOGIC & ACCURACY Test -The Canvassing Board** will test and seal the vote tabulation equipment to be used in all phases of the City of Gainesville Special Election. The test will be held at the Supervisor of Elections Office, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville.

**January 19 – Wednesday – 10:00 AM – The Canvassing Board will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office**, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, to review criteria used to accept vote-by-mail ballots, inspect, approve, open, and scan the vote-by-mail ballots, which have been received by the Supervisor of Elections. Ballots will be available for public inspection at 9:30 AM.

**January 21 – Friday – 1:00 PM – The Canvassing Board will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office**, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, to review and process additional vote-by-mail ballots received by the Supervisor of Elections. Ballot duplication may occur. Ballots will be available for public inspection at 12:30 PM.

**January 24 – Monday – 2:00 PM – The Canvassing Board will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office**, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, to review and process additional vote-by-mail ballots received by the Supervisor of Elections. Ballot duplication may occur. Ballots will be available for public inspection at 1:30 PM.

**January 25 – Tuesday – 3:00 PM – The Canvassing Board will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office**, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, to review and process additional vote-by-mail ballots received by the Supervisor of Elections. The Board will canvass the returns from early voting, vote-by-mail ballots and the precincts after 7:00 PM. Ballot duplication may occur. Ballots will be available for public inspection at 2:30 PM. Preliminary Results will be released.

**January 27 – Thursday – 4:30 PM – The Canvassing Board will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office**, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, to canvass election returns, review bad signatures and provisional ballots issues along with any evidence provided (final determinations made after 5:00 PM), and certify Official Results. Ballot duplication may also occur. The Board will then review the audit selection process and make selections for the post-election audit of the voting system.

**January 28 – Friday – 10:00 AM – The Canvassing Board will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office**, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, to review the audit process and conduct the post-election audit of the voting system per Florida Statutes.

**January 29 – Saturday – 10:00 AM – (if needed) The Canvassing Board will meet at the Supervisor of Elections Office**, 515 North Main Street, Suite 100, Gainesville, if needed, to complete the post-election audit.
