- ✓ Polls are open on election day from 7AM to 7PM.
- ✓ **POLLWORKERS URGENTLY NEEDED**, Call Elections at 374-5252.
- ✓ **To vote absentee**, call the Elections Office.
- ✓ **NEW VOTING SYSTEM**. To vote for the candidate of your choice, color in the oval on the left of the candidate's name. After voting, you will drop your ballot through a scanner which will record the votes and print out the results after the polls close.
- ✓ **State Law** requires voters to provide **PICTURE AND SIGNATURE ID**. You will not be turned away if you do not have it. You can sign an affidavit to vote. Your Voter ID card tells you the State House and Senate District you vote in, and where you vote.
- ✓ **IF YOU HAVE MOVED** since you registered to vote, please call the Elections Office to update your record. It will save you time on Election Day.
- ✓ **Pr. 27** will vote at Thomas Center, 302 NE 6<sup>th</sup> Ave, in October and November .
