## Voter Registration Deadline for 2018 City of Gainesville Run-Off Election is April 2

GAINESVILLE, Fla. (March 28, 2018) — City residents who live in District 1 and wish to vote in the 2018 City of Gainesville Run-Off Election need to be registered to vote by April 2.

Registered voters who reside within District 1 of Gainesville's city limits are able to vote in this election, which will be held May 1.

There are numerous ways for prospective voters to register:

- Online: Florida residents can register to vote online. The online voter registration portal — found at <u>RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov</u> — is a safe and secure option for voter registration.
- In person: The Alachua County Supervisor of Elections' office, located in Gainesville at 515 N. Main St., Suite 300, is open 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday. Registrations can also be completed and turned in at any Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles office or Alachua County Library District branch.
- After hours: The Alachua County Supervisor of Elections' office has a
  white after-hours drop box outside its main entrance. Completed forms
  received through the drop box by 11:59 p.m. April 2 will be accepted.

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• By mail: Forms are available online at <u>VoteAlachua.com</u>. Mailed forms must be completed and postmarked by the April 2 deadline.
