Alachua County Supervisor of Elections, UF's Bob Graham Center for Public Service, Santa Fe College Office of Civic Engagement and Service to host voter registration drive for National Voter Registration Day

GAINESVILLE, Fla. (September 24, 2018) — A voter registration drive will take place on Sept. 25 from 10:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at various locations across the University of Florida and Santa Fe College campuses.

The event, hosted by the University of Florida's Bob Graham Center for Public Service, Santa Fe College Office of Civic Engagement and Service and the Alachua County Supervisor of Elections, takes place on National Voter Registration Day.

In order to promote voter registration among students, faculty and staff, as well as provide information regarding the upcoming 2018 General Election, tables will be set up around both campuses at the following locations:

- Marston Science Library (UF)
- Library West (UF)
- Broward Hall (UF)
- Graham Area Commons (UF)

In 2016, the University of Florida's total student voters exceeded the amount of student voters in 2012 by more than 4,000, according to Tufts University's Jonathan M. Tisch College of Civic Life's National Study of Learning, Voting and Engagement (NSLVE) report.

The voter registration deadline is Oct. 9. In order to vote in Alachua County, a voter must be registered in Alachua County.
