2019 City of Gainesville Regular Election sample ballots mailed and available

GAINESVILLE, Fla. (March 7, 2019) — Sample ballots for the 2019 City of Gainesville Regular Election, which will be held March 19, have been mailed.

The sample ballot includes the candidates for Mayor and District 4 and the language of a proposed city charter amendment, as well as a list of precincts and polling locations. Information on early voting, vote-by-mail ballots, Election Day voting and other elections-related subjects are also on the sample ballot. The sample ballot is printed in both English and Spanish.

All registered voters who reside within Gainesville’s city limits are able to vote in this election.
